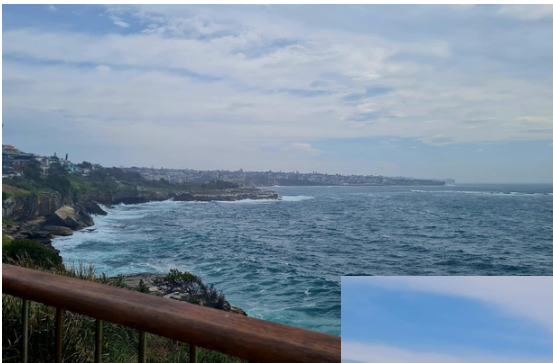
WOW - Wednesday 6 September 2023

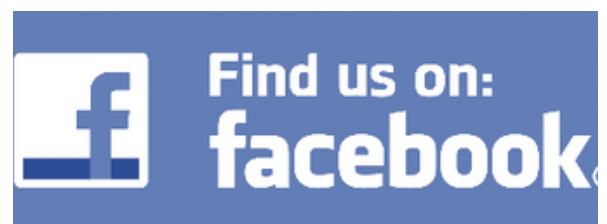
