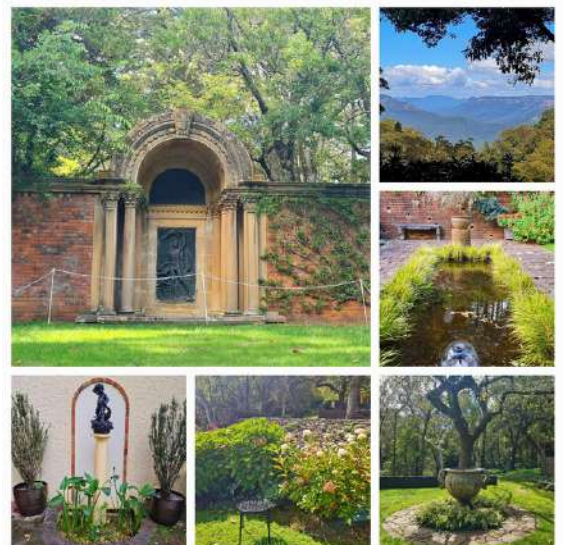
Wow walk 6 March 2024

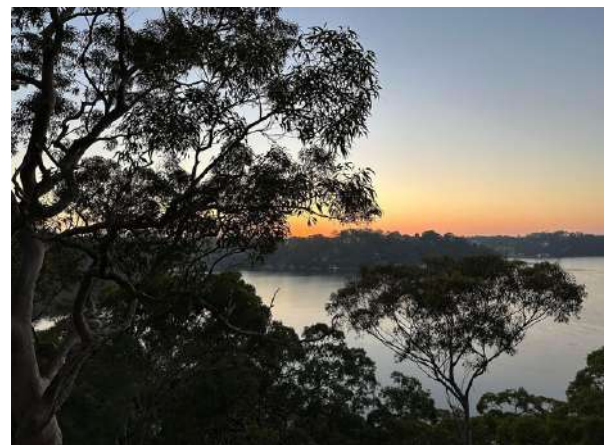
