Thursday 19 December 2024 - last walk for the year and Presentation night.

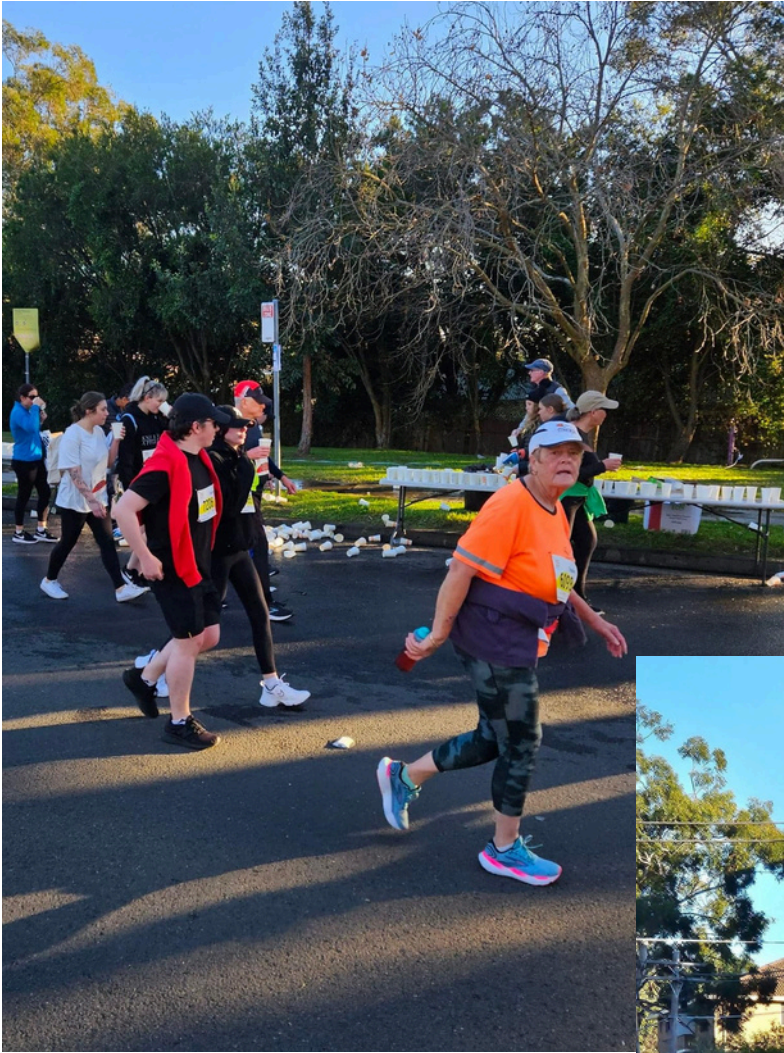
Tuesday 14 January 2025 - walking resumes.

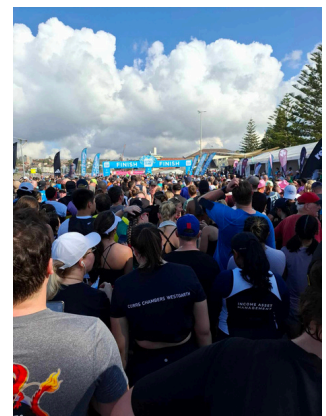


City to Surf - Sunday 11 August 2024

Denice, Paul, Anne, Kate and Liz enjoying a refreshing drink after their long walk.

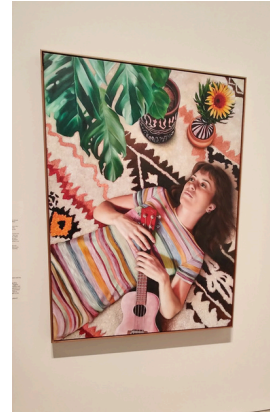


City to Surf - Sunday 11 August 2024 cont.

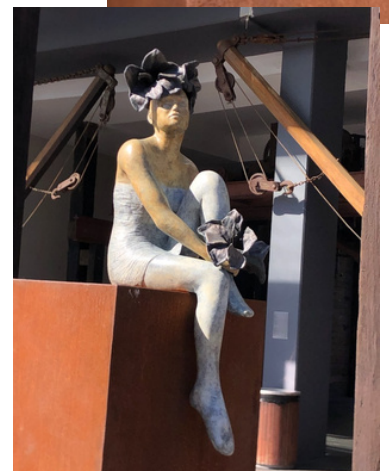
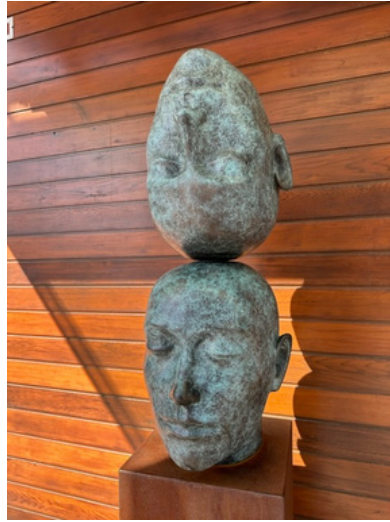


WOW Walsh Bay - 8th August 2024

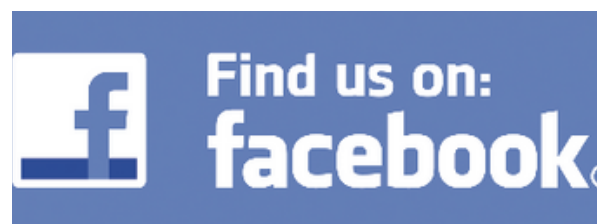
