Committee meeting outcomes 11 January 2025

A Peaky committee was convened on 11 January.

The committee has decided to change the format of presentation night. There will be no walk on presentation night, so count your walks if you are close to an award. The last walk will be on Wednesday 17 December.

There will be a total of 4 free walks (One Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday) will be offered randomly in October, replacing the pizza night (celebrating Daylight saving).

As participation of walk events has been declining, in 2025 Peaky striders will no longer offer 50% refund of the early bird entry fee. However in its place, when a peaky member attends a walk event in their Peaky uniform, 2 stamps will be given. The walks available for two stamps are Mt Annan, Canberra weekend, MS WALK, Mothers day walk, Sutherland to surf, City to surf, 7 Bridges walk, Memory walk, 5 Lands walk and Oatley fun run.

Recovery walk review - The committee reviewed the introduction in 2024 of the recovery group. The objective of the recovery group is to offer a transition for members returning to walking after an injury or illness to build up to an hour of walking, operating on a as needs basis. After a wide ranging discussion, it was decided to maintain this group as is. We do encourage members to use this as a way to build up strength and aim for the hours walk.

The social secretary, Judi, is proposing a social event weekend away in October/November and a sub group to be formed to assist in doing research (initially via computer) to assist with the planning of the event. Feel free to offer assistance (Talk to Judi) in this event, especially if you have computer skills.
